



Disciplinary Statement

Statement Reference: JOS 01/26

A spokesperson for the Judicial Office for Scotland said:

The Lord President has issued Ms Valerie Bremner, legal member of the First-tier Tribunal for Scotland, with formal advice.

In June 2025, the Judicial Office for Scotland received a complaint concerning undue delay in the issuing of a written determination in the Housing and Property Chamber.

The complaint was investigated in accordance with the *Complaints about Members of the Scottish Tribunals Rules 2024*. The nominated judicial office holder found the complaint to be substantiated and recommended that formal advice be issued.

The Lord President accepted that recommendation and, in terms of Schedule 8, paragraph 5 of the *Tribunals (Scotland) Act 2014*, has issued Ms Bremer with formal advice.

The *Guidance to Judicial Office Holders on Judicial Ethics in Scotland* provides that there should be no undue delay in the issuing of judicial decisions.
