



Policy on Publication of Disciplinary Statements

1. A statement will normally be published on the [Judiciary of Scotland](#) website where a complaint has been substantiated (or substantiated in part), and the Lord President has, for disciplinary purposes issued a judicial office holder with any of the following:
 - (a) formal advice;
 - (b) a formal warning;
 - (c) a reprimand;
 - (d) or any other action informally or for other purposes.

2. The Lord President may decide to:
 - (a) publish a statement;
 - (b) redact parts of a statement; or
 - (c) remove any published statement.

3. Published disciplinary statements will:
 - (a) be published for a period of 3 years;
 - (b) contain the name of the judicial office holder, and if the Lord President considers it appropriate, the name of the complainer; and
 - (c) a brief history of the complaint and the power used by the Lord President.
