

Dr Caroline Bruce, Principal Educator, NHS Education for Scotland

Dr Caroline Bruce was awarded a PhD in forensic psychology in 2002, and qualified as a clinical psychologist in 2005 following completion of the Doctorate in Clinical Psychology at the Institute of Psychiatry, Kings College London. From 2005 to 2016, she worked as a clinical psychologist for NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde, specialising in working with adults affected by childhood sexual abuse and other forms of complex psychological trauma. In 2013, she completed an LLB at the University of Strathclyde, and in the same year was appointed as Lecturer at the University of Glasgow Institute of Mental Health and Wellbeing, with research and teaching interests around the impact of psychological trauma on witnesses, particularly in relation to adult survivors of childhood sexual abuse.
